

MATERIALS LIST

CHARCOAL OVER WATERCOLOUR WASH -BABY ELEPHANT

I will provide the students with a good quality reference photo on the day.

I also have included a photo of the finished piece.

We will trace the structure drawing on the day to save time and try to ensure everyone has a finished drawing to take home on the day.

If you would prefer to draw the elephant outline yourself and have it ready to bring, I have included a gridded photo for you to draw from.

* One A3 size sheet of hot pressed watercolour paper 300 gsm is best.

*Charcoal pencils in HB, 2B, 4B and 6B, I use Generals brand.

*Sharpening knife or sharpener for charcoal pencils, also a piece of fine sandpaper for sanding a point on your pencils. I will bring my electric sharpener, if anyone would like to use it instead but it can cause breakages with charcoal pencils.

*kneadable eraser

*Kent brand battery operated precision eraser (around \$11.00 from Eckersleys) This brand has a small and larger eraser included as we will be using the smaller one. These are great for lifting highlights.

I will also be using a "Tombow MONO zero elastomer" propelling pen style eraser , size 2.3mm, which is very handy for some lifting of highlights.

*Paper (blending) stump in a few small and medium sizes. Available cheaply from most art or craft stores.

*Piece of grey graphite paper for tracing. I use "X-Press It" brand

*Board to attach your paper and masking tape

*Black watercolour eg. Ivory black

*Something to hold water for painting

*Paint brushes - sizes 8 10 12 14 if you have them
