En Plein Air Painting/Sketching Adventure

Thursday 13 August-Steyn Park, Double Bay.

This delightful harbour side park has numerous vessels, a lovely boatshed, huge fig trees, facilities and more. Getting there 1. CQ Ferry Wharf 2 09:57 arrive 10:13am don't be late as only hourly. Bus near Martin Place to Double Bay Route 324 & 325. Or Edgecliff Station Bus 324, 325, 328. OR walk down hill to the park approx 15 mins & steep.



Along with Diana Garth I recently attended a Combined Art Societies of Sydney Delegates meeting. It was great to see eleven Art Societies, out of 13, represented at that CASS Meeting, at Drummoyne Art Society.

Art Societies represented at the meeting were – Castle Hill, Continuum, Drummoyne, Ku-ring-gai, Lane Cove, Macquarie Towns, Mosman, Northern Beaches, Oatley 101, Randwick, and St. George. A really good attendance, only two societies could not make it to the meeting.

A major part of the meeting dealt with CASS Art Exhibitions – the first one – “Art at the Royal” – will be held at the Royal Art Society of NSW and will be made up of Award Winners and Finalists from the 2026 Art of Sydney Exhibition that was held at the St. George Motorboat Club. If you were one of those people you will be notified. The Opening for this Exhibition will be Friday 9th October – so if you are a person who just loves those Openings better write that date on your calendar now! The dates for this exhibition will be from the 6th October to the 1st November 2026.

The following exhibition is one we can all enter our paintings into, but they better be the best paintings we have, as there will be a selection for the Art of Sydney Exhibition!

And here I'd like to mention It was at one of the very early meetings that the Combined Art Societies held when it was suggested that our Art Societies should hold a Combined Exhibition. The first thing to discuss was “where would we hold it?” And without hesitation the person who suggested the idea said, “The Sydney Opera House, where else?” Haha, of course, hahaha! How silly of us not to know that! And we all had a good laugh until the conversation became more serious – it was no longer a laughing matter - people were serious! If we were going to hold the best Exhibition, with the very best work, it had to be at the very best venue! Without going into all the detail that transpired after that meeting, the very first Art of Sydney Exhibition was held in the Reception Hall at the Sydney Opera House in January 1991, and it was an Umbrella Event of the Sydney Festival!

Although it was deemed to be a great success at the time, it was an exhibition without selection and therefore the high standard of work that has been displayed in the Award Exhibitions that have followed was not apparent in 1991. What was obvious was the foresight of that first CASS Committee to make the initial approaches to the Sydney Opera House to hold such an exhibition in our wonderful city and the Opera House staff, at the time giving us the opportunity to do so. After that exhibition eight more Art of Sydney Exhibitions were held at the Sydney Opera House, until the Olympic Games came to Sydney and the CASS was seen to be not as important and was moved on!

But we didn't do too badly when we claimed The Terrace Room at the Australian National Maritime Museum at Darling Harbour for the next 17years!

Despite the venues in the City having become more expensive, and harder to locate, the 2027 CASS Art of Sydney Exhibition is to be held at the Botanic Garden Gallery, in the Botanical Gardens from the 20th January to the 31st January 2027. Gavin Bridge from Drummoyne Art Society is the CASS Exhibition Manager. Keep an eye out for more information as we get closer to the date.

Coming soon will be the Combined Art Societies of Sydney's Annual General Meeting, and it is to be held in our hall at 101 Woronora Pde. Oatley West – on the 30th August, 1.45pm to 4pm. A general meeting will follow the AGM, and all Oatley 101 financial members are welcome to attend.

We're contacting you as we're excited that the biennial Basil Sellers Art Prize is taking place this year. It's back and bigger than ever with a \$55,000 total prize pool.

Every two years, we're hugely impressed with the strength of entries and this year we want to crank it up.

The Basil Sellers Art Prize places artists at its heart, offering a supportive platform for 2D works in painting, drawing and printmaking. Held at the Bas in Moruya, on the South Coast of NSW, the Prize continues to refine an artist-first model, shaped by listening closely to creative practitioners and nurturing ongoing relationships with them.

The 2026 Prize strengthens this ethos with two major supports: courier fees fully covered and a \$100 framing subsidy for all finalists to improve accessibility and reduce exhibition costs. The major acquisitive award has been increased to \$50,000, alongside the \$5,000 Eurobodalla Award celebrating an outstanding local entry. All entry fees support local creative programming.

Open to artists at all career stages and from all regions of Australia, the Prize is committed to care, accessibility and the belief that exceptional art can come from anywhere.
